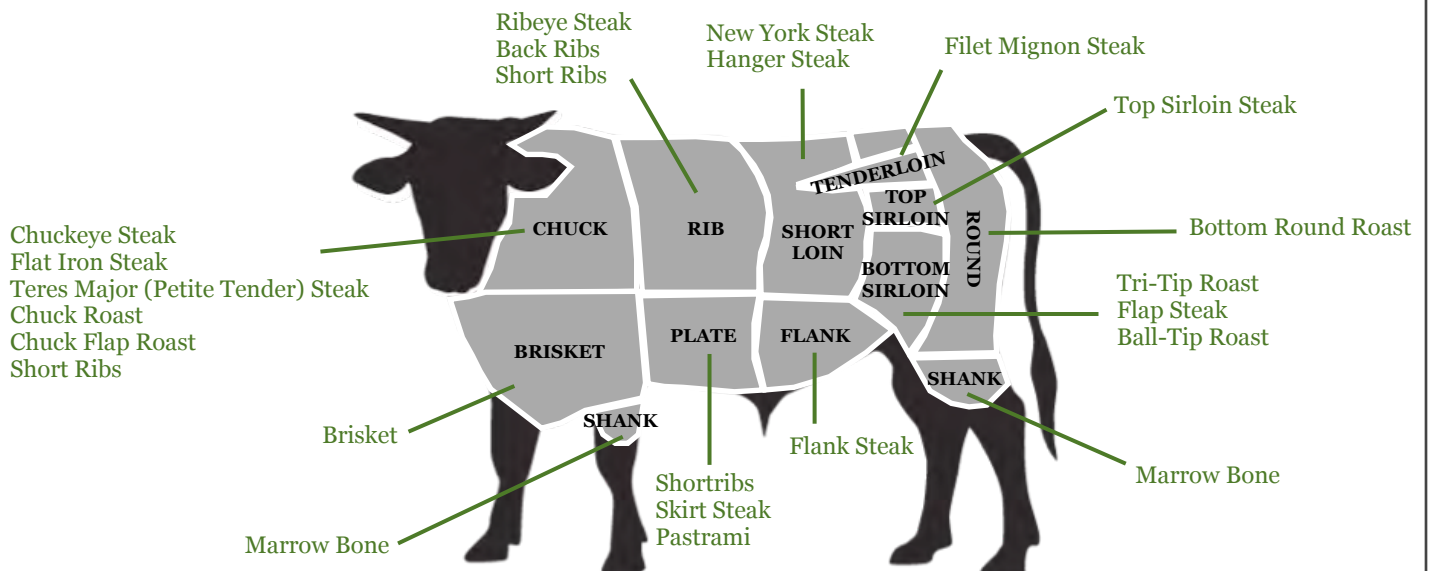
We will notify you of the status of your order within 24 hours after it is received. Once your order is confirmed, we will contact you directly to schedule a pick up.

2015 BEEF SALE PROCEEDS DONATED TO BUTTE FIRE SURVIVORS

On June 9th, we delivered a check for \$1,540 - 50% of the proceeds from our beef sale after October 1, 2015 - to [Calaveras Recovers](#), a local non-profit organization. The organization is dedicated to helping rebuild Calaveras County following the devastating Butte Wildfire, which ripped through the region in September 2015, consuming 71,000 acres of land, destroying over 800 structures and taking two lives.

According to Allan Sender, Chair of the Board of Directors, two houses are under construction with almost all work being donated by local contractors. "We plan to build 6 or so more houses this year, 15 in 2017 and another 15 in 2018," says Allan. Donations will go towards materials and all labor will be provided by volunteer groups including those from other states and as far as Canada!

The fire is out now, but there's still more work to be done. We hope this small contribution will help at least one family get back on their feet. Thank you to all our customers for your support! This donation would not have been possible without you!
